1. Audition for the Prince George's Philharmonic

Prince George's Philharmonic announces auditions for the 2010-2011 season. Two audition dates are scheduled.

Auditions for Principal Second Violin will be held on Tuesday, September 7, 2010, from 7:00pm until 10:00pm, at Oaklands Presbyterian Church in Laurel, Maryland. This is a paid position. The current fee is \$90.00 per service.

General Auditions will be held on Wednesday, September 8, 2010, from 7:00pm until 10:00pm at Northwestern High School for all strings, 2 rotating horn positions and for substitutes for wind, brass and percussion. All open positions are non-compensated, volunteer positions. Please prepare two solo works of contrasting styles (or two contrasting movements of the same solo work). Woodwind and brass players should also prepare several standard orchestral excerpts of their choice. In addition, candidates on all instruments will be asked to play an excerpt from the standard repertoire which they will receive upon arrival at the audition venue.
